Additional Information

Versatility Excellent:

Versatility Excellent is intended to show not only versatility in terms engagement in a variety of dog sport activities but also to demonstrate advancement beyond the novice level in a variety of activities. This award thus requires variety and demonstration of increased skill, indicated by the requirement for a minimum of 2 points per activity in 4 categories.

It is also intended to show that the dog conforms to the breed standard in structure / temperament and / or function hence the requirement for either conformation or and earthdog / barn hunt title.

Definitions:

Category - a group of related activities / sports

Activity – an individual activity or sport within a designated category (each column in a table represents a different activity). Where there is more than one activity per category, points may be claimed in each category towards the final point tally.

Level – title or performance level (each line in the table represents a level)

Some activities have a variety of different titling organizations – points can be achieved under multiple titling organizations but within a specific level, points will be awarded for only a single titling organization.

Please note that not all titles are awarded points.

- For some titling organizations, only higher-level titles are awarded points.
- Additional points are not awarded for titles higher than those listed in the tables.
- Not all titling organizations are recognized under this program.
- Please contact a committee member if you have questions about the eligibility of a title or event.

Be sure to include a copy of each title certificate with your application.
